

LITCHFIELD SCHOOL DISTRICT GOALS 2009-2010

Increase achievement for all students.

- A. Increase the median RIT score of the NWEA for each grade level in both Math & Reading on an annual basis.
- B. Increase the school index scores in each sub-group to the State identified level of proficiency or by 10% as measured by NECAP in both reading & mathematics annually.
- C. Increase the percentage of students performing at proficient with distinction as measured by NECAP in both reading and mathematics annually.
- D. Create trees of intervention for all students to support and improve individual student achievement.
- E. Implement Kindergarten Programming.
- F. Meet accountability requirements (SB 180) to be determined by the State of NH by the recommended timeframe.
- G. Celebrate outstanding academic achievement at all schools.

Develop confident, responsible and productive students with post-graduate aspirations.

- A. Implement the Comprehensive Guidance action plan over the next five years.
- B. Promote health and wellness by continuing to implement the Wellness policy.
- C. Track alumni accomplishments and gain programmatic advisement through Lifetrack, building constructed surveys, and alumni forms.

Maintain a safe, supportive and effective learning environment.

- A. Create a documentation plan for individual student progress academically, socially, emotionally, and physically.
- B. Facilitate the development of digital portfolios for all 8th grade students by June 2010.
- C. Increase student engagement.
- D. Support teachers as they participate in professional learning communities encouraging collaboration, analysis of student work, and refinement of lessons and instructional strategies.
- E. Develop and implement a preventative maintenance program for all facility related assets.

Increase community awareness of and involvement in the Litchfield School District.

- A. Expand the adult education program for the Litchfield community.
- B. Increase the publication of the District Community Newsletter to quarterly and expand electronic delivery options.
- C. Create quarterly cable programming focusing on district issues and Board actions.
