

8th graders continued to build and test their race cars. There was such creativity in what they were building and smiles were all over the 8th grade as they worked and planned.

Finally to clarify some confusion surrounding iReady and it's use with students here at LMS, it is not about a test or test prep. This program does offer assessment which is given only in the fall, winter and spring to help provide information for teachers on areas of strength for students. Additionally, iReady has an individual "my learning path" that provides games, lessons and activities, directly at a student's instructional level. Teachers are using one of these lessons in Math and one in Reading each week to provide direct instruction in individualized ways for students. This allows both acceleration and remediation on an individual basis during the week ranging from 15-30 minutes in total time for lesson completion.
