The Litchfield School District has adopted the ALICE response protocol for emergencies in our schools. Working with state and local law enforcement, this protocol teaches a proactive response to school emergencies including intruder emergencies.

All Litchfield School District employees have been trained in the ALICE protocol, which has been shown through recent research to increase the rate of survival during an active shooter incident.
