Articulation Agreement Southern New Hampshire University and Campbell High School

November 14, 2013..... Southern New Hampshire University (SNHU) and Campbell High School (CHS), are pleased to announce their admission articulation scholarship agreement.

SNHU will grant a \$3,000 admission articulation scholarship to qualified students (2.50 GPA or better) who submit a completed application for admission by February 1, 2014. Admission decisions will be made within 30 days. This scholarship will be in addition to any go-getter or academic scholarships received (outlined below).

SNHU awards academic go-getter grants and academic scholarships up to \$15,000/year to qualified applicants. Scholarship dollars amounts are calculated by the student's GPA and curriculum at the conclusion of first, quarter senior year. Students are encouraged to take the most challenging level of core courses that they can be successful in. SNHU requires a minimum at college prep curriculum for admission consideration. Core Classes include the completion of 4 years of English, 3 years of Math (successfully completing Algebra II), History, and Science.

- If a student is the recipient of other grants, scholarships or benefits such as tuition or military benefits that would cause that student's award to exceed the cost of attendance, SNHU reserves the right to adjust the award.
- SNHU is a test optional school. Students who do take the ACT or SAT are able to submit their test scores.
- Waived \$40 application fee.
- Choice between commuting or residing on campus.
- Non-binding acceptance to SNHU that allows seniors to continue to make final enrollment decisions before May 1st.
- Possible college credit for the successful completion of Running Start, AP or IB courses taken during high school
- Articulation scholarships and academic go-getter grants and scholarships are renewable all 4 years at SNHU provided a student meets satisfactory academic progress at the college level as outlined by their specific award.
- Additional financial aid consideration if a student completes the FAFSA form by the priority deadline of March 15th.
- The Admission Scholarship Agreement will be reviewed and renewed on an annual basis with CHS.
